Biography: Charles Dobie is from Ontario. He served in the Royal Canadian Navy and worked for the *Toronto Star*. He also worked as a photographer for *Guerilla*, an underground alternative newspaper based in Toronto. Charles Dobie and his partner, Peter Zorzi, were two of the founders of the *Body Politic* and were involved with the Toronto Area Gays organization.
