MG 55 – Lorne and Mildred Paul fonds

Dates: [ca. 1880s] -1985 (inclusive); 1912-1974 (predominant).

Extent: 1.54 m of textual records and photographs; oversize.

Biography: Lorne Caswell Paul was born in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan, on 27 October 1904, and received both his BSc in Biology (1930) and his MSc (1932) from the University of Saskatchewan. He earned a PhD from Iowa State University in 1940. Paul joined the faculty at the University of Saskatchewan in 1944 as Extension Specialist and assistant professor, and was promoted in turn to associate professor (1957) and full professor (1968). He held positions in various organisations, including that of Saskatchewan Director for the Agriculture Institute of Canada, and Director of the Saskatchewan Institute of Agrologists. Paul retired from the University in 1972. He died at the age of 100, on 16 December 2004.

Scope and context: This fonds contains biographical material, including a Paul family history and reminiscences and anecdotes by L.C. Paul, as well as several of his articles. In addition, there is both the manuscript and published version of the *History of Extension* (1910-1970), and a file on the Retired Faculty Association. The addendum includes clippings and articles pertaining to the history of agricultural science in general and in the Canadian West in particular.
