

MG 268: NeWest Review fonds

Dates:- 1981-2000 (inclusive); 1985-1995 (predominant).

Extent: 1.22 m of textual records, 55 photographs/negatives, oversize.

Administrative History: Originally established in Edmonton in 1976, the *NeWest Review* was 'a new magazine for the new West,' promoting a 'radical regionalism' and intended as an antidote and alternative to the central Canadian and U.S.-dominated mainstream culture. University of Saskatchewan professor Don Kerr moved the publication to Saskatoon in 1981. The magazine had contributing editors in all major prairie cities, four volunteers serving as an overall editorial group, and volunteer directors - 20 individuals - working as a collective based in Saskatoon.

Scope and Content: This fonds is comprised of administrative records for the publication, files relating to contributors and content, as well as useful collection of images and graphics used within the publication.
