Administrative history

Moose Jaw: The Buckle of the Greatest Wheat Belt in the World was published by Rice's Studio in 1913. Rice's Studio, owned by Lewis Rice, was located in Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan and offered services in photography, illustration and publication. Rice was born in Bedeque (now Baddeck), Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia in 1862 and demonstrated artistic abilities at an early age. He moved to Moose Jaw with his wife in 1906 and was an active member of the community. He was a local business owner, the vice-president of the Board of Trade and the founder of the Aquatic Club. A photographer, illustrator, and publisher, Lewis Rice illustrated for the Board of Trade and the CPR. His photographs won multiple awards, including top awards at the Dominion Fair in Toronto in 1912. Rice died October 14, 1913 in Moose Jaw.

Scope and content

This fonds contains three copies of the promotional booklet *Moose Jaw: The Buckle of the Greatest Wheat Belt in the World.* It was published in 1913 by Rice's Studio, with Lewis Rice as publisher. It includes facts and figures about Moose Jaw as well as photographs and illustrations of the town. Many of the photographs were taken by Rice. The booklets bear a stamp from the Moose Jaw Board of Trade.

Physical condition

The promotional booklet (MJ133.001) is in poor physical condition. The paper is discoloured and the edges are curled. The promotional booklets (MJ133.002 and MJ133.003) are in good physical condition.

Conservation note

This fonds was reboxed, refoldered and wrapped in mylar in 2012.
