This file consists of four volumes of original minutes of the Saskatchewan Conference. The first volume begins with extracts from the minutes of the Proceedings of the Manitoba and North West Conference, June 1904, at which the Assiniboia Conference, predecessor of the Saskatchewan Conference, was formed. At the 1906 Assiniboia Conference a request was made of General Conference that the name be changed to Saskatchewan Conference. The first conference under the new name was held at Regina in June, 1907. Some localities in Manitoba were included in districts of the Assiniboia and Saskatchewan Conferences.

Besides having minutes of the Annual Conference, these volumes also have reports and station lists which are also included in the published minutes. (Oversize.)

These are published minutes for the Saskatchewan Conference and for its predecessors, published under variant titles as the Manitoba and North-West Conference, the Manitoba Conference, the Manitoba, Assiniboia and Alberta Conferences, the Manitoba and Saskatchewan Conferences, the Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta Conferences, and the Saskatchewan Conference.

All of these volumes contain reports, statistical information and station lists and clergy for areas included in the Saskatchewan Conference and for other Conferences and areas stated in the title of the publication. Some localities in Manitoba were included in the Assiniboia and Saskatchewan Conferences.

A.W. Ingram and A.W. Keeton with church officials and clergy concerning arrangements for annual Conference, the appointment, resignation, transfer and stationing of clergy, and changes to the Methodist Year Book. Correspondence from clergy sometimes includes passing comments on church union. The file is sorted generally in alphabetical order by name of correspondent. One group of letters at the end of the file is about Summer Supply in each field and the name of the Superintendant in charge.

This Commission was appointed by the Saskatchewan Conference to inquire into the circumstances of the retirement from Wesley College, Winnipeg, of Dr. S.G. Bland and Dr. A.J. Irwin.

These proceedings were held at Winnipeg, September 4 - 7, 1918, and were adjourned until September 12, at which time Dr. Eber Crummy was a witness. The file includes "Transcript of evidence and proceedings heard and held by special committee of Saskatchewan Conference at Regina on Thursday, September 12, 1918, enquiring into the circumstances of the retirement from Wesley College of Dr. Bland
