Biography: Born in Vancouver on August 10, 1944, Victor Graham Wiebe began his academic career by studying Chemistry at the University of British Columbia, earning a B.Sc. in 1966 and M.Sc. in 1968. He went on to study at University of Western Ontario earning a M.L.S. in 1974. Mr. Wiebe worked at the National Research Council before joining the U of S faculty as a Librarian I in 1976. He worked in variety of Library Departments including; Reference, Government Publication, Engineering and Veterinary Medicine before retiring in 2008 as a Librarian IV.

Scope and Content: This fonds contains two distinct sets of material. The first documents Wiebe's career at the University Library and the second his participation in the activities of the University of Saskatchewan Faculty Association (USFA).
