Moved by Mc Bride & Fowle that we get Railroad annex from street leading Presbyterian Church up to street near Lumber yard. Carried. Moved by Fowle and Amison that the Council accept Messrs Phillips Bros offer of Hall at \$400 per month heat and light included. Carried. Moved by Fowle and Amison that we adjour untill called by Secy.

Reeler Sask Aug 16 - 1910

Regular Meeting of Town Council held tonight in Phillips Bros Hall at 9 PM. Present Messrs Amison, Fowle & Mc Bride. Minutes of last meeting read and approved.
