
Dear Sir:-

In reply to yours dated December ninth I regret that I am compelled still to say that neither your engraved certificates or trophy cup have arrived from Kansas City. They seem to be taking plenty of time about it.

As you say, there is just a possibility that your Red Bobs wheat and Marquis wheat got mixed, but definite instructions were sent from here in accordance with your list that the Marquis was to be entered in the open classes and your Red Bobs in the Dry-Farming. I do not see how they could mistake the varieties, unless some very careless work was done. Further, when no one was present from here I do not see how we can find out anything further on it. However, I will try to get more details from those who were there. The reports have all gone to show that the Marquis won the C.P.R. cup, although when the exhibits left here I would have

staked more on the Red Bobs myself. The
only fault was possibly in the color of
the Red Bobs, otherwise it was a beautiful
kernel and the whole sample especially
uniform. Will write you further.
